"In Ireland's financial services industry, just 13% of those at Chief Executive level are women, according to data published by the 30% Club. The Women in Finance Awards came to Ireland with a clear message: to redress this gender imbalance by showcasing the achievements of women in the sector and identifying new role models. This is the responsibility of all members of the financial industry in Ireland and all the nominees at this event have made an enormous contribution to the furtherance of equality in the financial sector."

Commented Darina Barrett, Partner KPMG, who gave the headline address at the gala awards dinner held at the Clontarf Castle Hotel, Dublin.

Already established in London, the Women in Finance Awards is Europe's largest diversity initiative recognising the high-achievers, advocates, and role models for women in the sector. Organised
